- Rebuked for tolerating teachings like those of Balaam and the Nicolaitans, involving idolatry and immorality. [executableoutlines +2]
- Called to repent or face Christ's judgment symbolized by the sharp two-edged sword. [blueletterbible +2]

Promise: Hidden manna and a white stone with a new, secret name for the one who conquers. [biblehub +1]

Thyatira (2:18–29)

- Praised for love, faith, service, and growing works. [executableoutlines +2]
- Rebuked for tolerating a false prophetess called “Jezebel,” who leads believers into sexual immorality and idolatry. [shmoop +2]
- Warned of severe judgment on her and her followers unless they repent; Jesus declares He searches hearts and minds and repays according to deeds. [bibleref +1]
- The faithful remnant is told to hold fast until Christ comes. [biblehub +1]

Promise: Authority over the nations, ruling with a rod of iron, and the gift of the morning star to those who overcome and keep His works to the end. [bibleref +1]
